1. INTRODUCTION: BBK "DAJ KRUG" Bihac is a sports organization with its headquarters located in Bihac.

The club is made up of over 100 members which are divided into 5 age categories in the racing team.

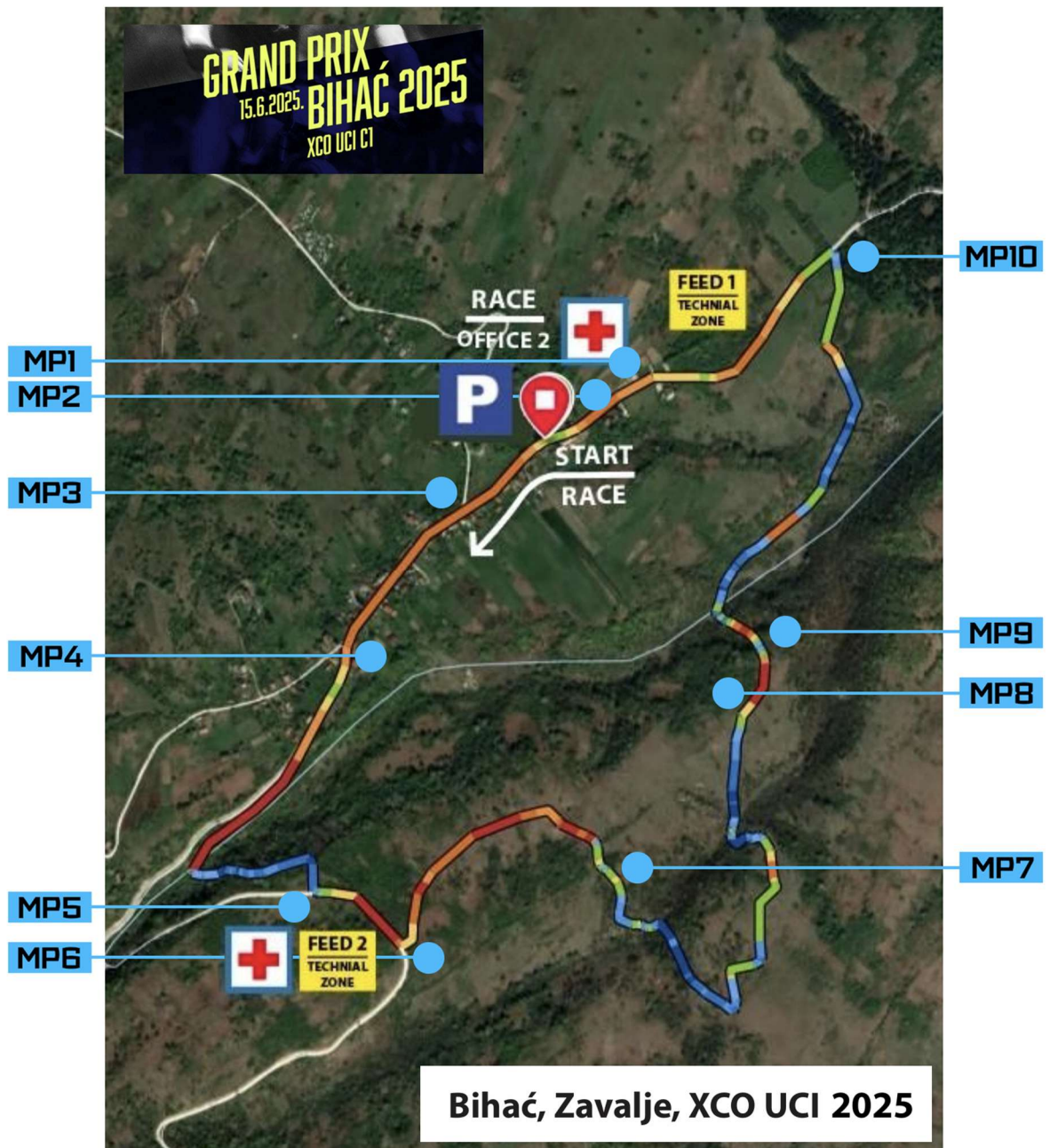
Since 2008, when the club was founded, we have organized a large number of national and international sporting events. Some of the most popular are races from BiHs MTB premier league, BiHs championship in the XCO discipline 2020, the BALKAN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021, the GRAND PRIX BIHAC 2022, and most recently the GRAND PRIX BIHAC 2023 and 2024. BBK "DAJ KRUG" is especially committed to the development of cycling tourism in this part of the country. Through the organization of recreational events, they are actively promoting tourist potential and the national park "Una".

2. DESCRIPTION & TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE TRACK: The circular (XCO) track is located on Zavalje – a village in Bihac u gradu Bihac in the sub-Pljesevica zone. The track is 4.300 m long with an elevation of 139m per lap and is mostly made up of soil. It is located at 340m above sea level. A large part of the track leads through forest areas. The main characteristic of the track is that it is „single track“, which in selected areas has very technical parts like the "rock garden", the "drops", descents and similar. In the case of bad weather, a large part will be driven on soft terrain and mud.

3. BASIC INFORMATION ABOUT THE MICRO & MACRO LOCATION (CANTON-CITY):

The city of Bihac is located in the north-west part of Bosnia and Herzegovina and serves as the administrative headquarters of the Unsko-sanski canton or Canton 1 of the Federation of BiH.

The city of beautiful nature and hospitality lies on the shores of the river Una, in the valley of the mountain Pljesevica which forms the border to the Republic of Croatia.

Bihac is one of the few cities in Bosnia and Herzegovina which despite urbanization managed to keep the original town-walls that formed the backbone of the former fortress Bihac. 1260. Was the first time it was mentioned in a document of the Hungarian king Bela IV.

The old walls are surrounded by the river Una and its sleeve. Together they form the island “Otok sv. Ladislava” (“Island of St. Ladislav”).

Grand Prix Bihać and the UCI race will be held on 15.06.2025 beginning at 10.00 a.m. for the amateur, youth and master categories, at 11:20 a.m. for the JUNIOR categories UCI C1 race, while the ELITE categories UCI C1 starts at 1.05 p.m.

Only licensed contenders have the right to participate.

Contenders participate at their own risk. The organizers are not responsible for the behavior of contenders during the race or towards third parties.

When receiving their starting number, the contender has to sign a statement of own responsibility.

All contenders have to wear helmets and drive a safe-to-ride bicycle.

Distribution of the starting numbers:

Starting numbers will be distributed on day before the race 14th of June from 04:00 p.m. – 08.00 p.m. in the Race Office 1 and on the day of the race 15th of June until 10.00 a.m. in the Race Office 2

Early and regular registrations will be evidenced, and payments can be made to the bank account of the club in UniCredit Bank dd Mostar or in person when picking up the starting numbers (payments will be calculated based on the date of paying e.g. early and late registration).

Registration for Grand Prix Bihac 2025 XCO includes:

- Zones for food and technical support (two each per round) – teams are required to provide support themselves (FEED ZONE 1 is located 900m before the start/finish line, FEED ZONE 2 is located approx. 200m after the start/finish line)

- Medals for the first three places in the YOUNG CADET U15 MEN & WOMEN race + sponsored gift

In any case of not participating and withdrawals from the race the entry-fee will not be refunded.

Confirmation for the start of the race and distribution of the starting numbers:

- **RACE OFFICE 1 Address: Bosanska 4, city square Bihac from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. 14th of June 2025**
- **RACE OFFICE 2 on Zavalje Address: Zavalje – Bihac on the day of the race 15th of June 2025 from 8 a.m. until 10 a.m.**

Race regulations:

- All possible changes and deviations will be published on the bulletin board of the race visible to all competitors. Every team, team leader and competitor are obligated to inform themselves about possible changes. The official Facebook-site will also have a virtual bulletin board which will be updated frequently.
- The propositions follow the general UCI-rules, BiSaBIH-rules, and specific regulations for mountain biking.
- Every contender will have to be in their given box at least 15min before the start of the race. Every box will be marked for each category.
- Every unauthorized aid to the drivers of the race will be followed by disqualification.
- Every distance, elevation, track type, waypoint, crossings, feed and technical zone, and time period for assisting will be marked accordingly.
- The race book reports about the neutralization of the start and finish point as well as the distance of the neutralized part and the added time between the finish line and the control points. This book is informative and is not required to follow every phase of the race.

Route;

- The route is marked according to UCI rules, especially on important parts of the route like crossings, roads or dangerous parts on both sides of the track.
- The route includes very demanding technical parts. It is the contenders responsibility to decide whether they're capable of driving the race or not.

The organizer is not responsible for accidents in connection with the drivers capability or skill level.

- At control points the inspector writes down the starting number and the time of passing for every contender.
- Any skipping of waypoints will lead to disqualification
- If the contenders do not comply with markings or in any other way don't follow the described route, they will be disqualified.
- The length of one lap is 4.300m.
- The height difference per lap is 139m.
- The time per lap is 15-20 min.
- The number of laps depends on the categories of the drivers.

Zones for food and technical assistance

- **Zones for food and technical assistance are marked according to the guidelines and are located at two locations. It is the team's responsibility to provide adequate food and technical assistance.**

Marking;

- **The course is marked with arrows and tapes. It doesn't require electronic editing.**
- **Every kilometer will be marked with the distance to the finish line.**

Unforeseen events;

- **The race commissioner and director can decide to end the race.**
- **The track can be rerouted through alternative points that have been selected by the organizer and or commissioner.**

Withdrawal;

- **Contenders that withdraw from the race have to give notice to the organizers and referee as soon as possible.**
- **Not giving notice on time will lead to disqualification.**
- **In the case of an accident or emergency, and taking the safety of the contenders in account, the organizer has the right to withdraw a contender from the race.**

Results;

- Results of the race are staggered in line with the times it takes to finish a race plus time penalties.
- The total amounts of time for finished races and time penalties establishes placement.
- The following results were established:
- A list of results will be made for UCI Junior and Elite men and women so that these contenders can receive UCI points and a cash reward.
- All contenders will receive a chip for electronic time tracking.
- Any contender who does not finish the race in time will not receive any points or prizes.

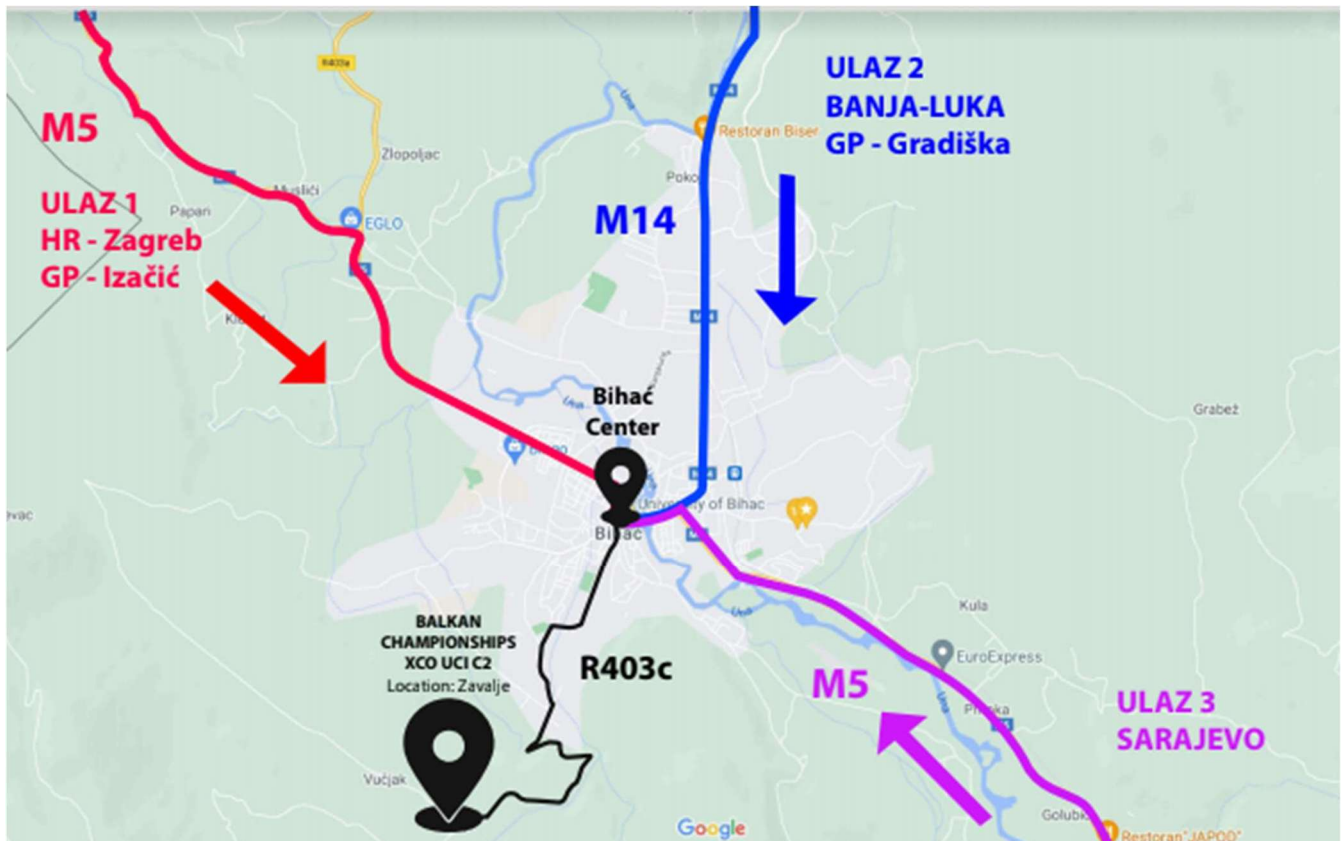

Early registration of teams and contenders for the Grand Prix Bihac 2025 XCO UCI C1 race ends on the 31st of May 2025 which includes a registration fee for the categories ELITE & JUNIOR / MEN & WOMEN: 60BAM – 30 EUR (guaranteed starter pack for registrations before 31st of May 2025)

Early registration of licensed teams and contenders of other categories (not ELITE & JUNIOR) for the Grand Prix Bihac 2025 XCO race ends on the 31st of May 2025 and does not include a registration fee

Early registration of unlicensed (amateur) teams and contenders for the Grand Prix Bihac 2025 XCO race ends on the 31st of May 2025 8 p.m., registration fee: 10BAM – 5EUR

10. RULES OF THE RACE – STATEMENT FROM THE ORGANIZER:

The race is being organized in accordance with the standards and regulations set by UCI. The organizer is obligated to follow these standards and regulations. The implementation of said rules will be controlled by a UCI delegate.

11. ACCREDITATIONS:

Team leader

Team leader - receives the accreditation TYPE A.
Team leader – with this accreditation has full freedom to move around and access to all areas that have been assigned to the event by the organizer.
The accreditation is signed with a big letter A and it will say “Team leader”

Coach

The Coach receives the accreditation TYPE A.
The Coach with this accreditation will be able to access the track, feed and technical zones, parking and the accommodation for the teams.
The accreditation is signed with a big letter **A** and it will say “Coach”

Staff and other members of the team

Staff of the team will receive the accreditation TYPE B.
Staff with this accreditation will be able to access the feed and technical zones, parking and accommodation for the teams
The accreditation is signed with a big letter **B** and it will say “Staff”

Press

Press will receive the accreditation TYPE C.
Press with this accreditation will be able to watch the race from a distance, accommodation for the teams and the organizers office
The accreditation is signed with a big letter **C** and it will say “Press”

14. PARKING

The organizer has provided parking spaces for the teams near the race track.
The street for parking will be open until the start of the first race 10:00 a.m., after that it will be temporarily closed until the end of the event.

15. CATERING

The organizer is required to provide food – lunch on the day of the race for all participants.
All other days the teams have to provide food for themselves.
For referees, commissioner and members of the organization board the organizer is required to provide food for their entire stay.

16. PRESS – REPORTERS – MEDIA

On the day of the race all media houses will be invited.
For press members a place will be provided for their stay during the race day. Press members will be informed earlier about the rules and the propositions for the race including their accreditations.

Participants in amateur categories – unlicensed underage participants – are required to have a signed statement from their parents, which can be signed in the race offices during registration. All participants that register lose their right to declare any liability on the organizers.***
